Inbound Officer Training Reporting Procedures

All inbound Active Duty, Guard, and Reserve Officer students attending the 14N course and arriving at GAFB **prior** to **15 August 2023** will reside off-base and will be required to procure their own living arrangements in the local community. EXCEPTION, if the student plans to bring their family they may be eligible for Base Housing and can contact GAFB Housing after receiving their orders. Members may also submit hardship exemptions to reside in the dormitories that will be approved on a case-by-case basis, the 315 TRS First Sergeants are the points of contact for processing hardship requests.

All new accession in-bound ACTIVE Duty Officers arriving <u>15 August 2023 or later</u> will be required to live <u>ON BASE</u> in dormitories. All new accession Active-Duty students MUST report to Bldg. 530 and to the casual office (aka Fishbowl) for coordination on receiving dorm room assignments. EXCEPTIONS may apply. If a student plans to bring their family, contact GAFB Housing at (325) 654-3498 ASAP after receiving orders. Students may be eligible for Base Housing or off Base Housing.

Any Prior-Service (Crossflow), Guard, or Reserve Officer members attending the 14N course in TDY status are required to procure lodging IAW the Joint Travel Regulation. Please contact Goodfellow AFB Lodging, commercial 325-654-5860 or 3332 (DSN: 477-5860/3332) to reserve a room or secure a non-availability letter as applicable.
