## How does the Wait List work?

You will be given your true number on the wait list and how many families are ahead of you when you submit your housing application. Your place on the wait list may fluctuate from time to time. Families who are in a lease are still eligible for offers and we tailor an offer to coincide with their lease ending date. As the month progresses, families ahead of you who's leases are expiring will be counted as being eligible for a housing offer. Your position on the wait list will move based on the amount of leases expiring ahead of you.

Other factors that may effect your position on the wait list are:

- EFMP families
- Families with a 1 year remote credit
- Key and Mission Essential personnel
