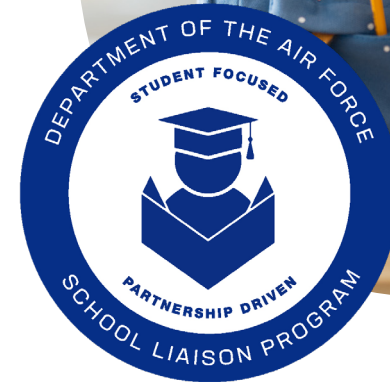

**PRIVATE SCHOOL** is a choice for parents and there are school tuition organizations (STO's) that can assist with scholarships. **CHARTER SCHOOLS** are public, state-funded schools and cannot charge tuition. They receive state funding like those of the other Public School Districts. Charter schools contract with the state, or a district, to provide an education service. Charter schools were created to provide additional academic choices for parents and students.
