# **General Education Information for the State of Delaware**

**Delaware Department of Education** (<u>https://education.delaware.gov/</u>): The DOE website is a wonderful resource for parents new to the area providing information such as registration requirements, school testing and accountability, and state curriculum guidelines. Parents will find that registration requirements for school districts may vary, so they are encouraged to contact the applicable school district for specific information.

**Home Schooling** (https://education.delaware.gov/families/homeschools-andprivate-schools/): The Delaware Code requires all nonpublic schools to register with the Department of Education (DOE). This includes both private schools and homeschools. Regulations and information on how to create a home school and register your child for a home school are available by visiting the website above.

### • Delaware School Choice Program

(https://education.delaware.gov/families/school-choice/): The Delaware School Choice Program began in the 1996-1997 School Year, and provides parents and students the opportunity to attend schools outside of their attendance area. The number of students that a district can accept in a particular school and grade will be determined by the receiving district's board of education and based on the building's capacity, class size policy, the program requirements, the projected enrollment for each school and child's grade for the next school year and/or other criteria determined by the school board. Although there are a few exceptions, transportation is not provided to students enrolled through School Choice and is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. School Choice applications are due the second Wednesday in January by 4:00 p.m. Charter schools may continue to accept applications after the second Wednesday in January but for the charter schools that have a lottery, the lottery will be based on the applications received by the second Wednesday in January. A parent enrolling their child in kindergarten may submit the standard application form to the receiving district up until the first day of the school year for enrollment in kindergarten during that school year. #### Delaware Multi-Tiered System of Support (DE-MTSS)

DE-MTSS uses team-based leadership and data driven decision making to meet the academic and nonacademic (behavioral, social, emotional) needs of all students.

**Interscholastic Sports** (https://education.delaware.gov/diaa/): The Delaware Interscholastic Athletic Association (DIAA) is responsible for overseeing interscholastic sports programs in Delaware secondary schools. The purpose of the Delaware Interscholastic Athletic Association is to preserve and promote the educational significance of interscholastic athletics; ensure that interscholastic sports remain compatible with the educational mission of the member schools; provide for fair competition between member schools; promote sportsmanship and ethical behavior; establish and enforce standards of conduct for athletes, coaches, administrators, officials and spectators; protect the physical well-being of athletes; and promote healthy adolescent lifestyles.

#### Wellness Centers

(<u>https://dhss.delaware.gov/dhss/dph/chca/dphsbhchome01.html</u>): All 6 Kent County high schools, as well as 38 others throughout the state, have School-Based Health Centers (SBHCs) through a contract with the Division of Public Health (DPH). Through primary prevention and early intervention, Delaware SBHCs provides the following services to various student populations by:

- providing preventive care
- $\circ$  detecting signs of emotional stress and psychosocial problems for





- counseling and/or referral
- facilitating students' use of health care systems by establishing links with primary health care providers

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- o promoting on-going comprehensive health care for students of all ages
- encouraging parent involvement in the health of their adolescents
- working toward the improvement of the students' knowledge of the importance of preventive health care
- o improving (responsible) decision-making about health matters
- reducing risk-taking behaviors
- developing health promoting behaviors
- providing early detection of chronic conditions and early diagnosis and treatment of minor and acute illnesses and health problems.

**Delaware Goes to College** (https://delawarestudentsuccess.org/dgca/): The Delaware Department of Education is dedicated to helping high school students apply to colleges. The Delaware Goes to College organization conducts research, creates community partnerships, provides supports and resources, and engages in a statewide text and social media campaign designed to facilitate the college application process. DGTC also provides education, supports and resources to assist parents and students with understanding and accessing the financial aid process.

• Curriculum Standards (https://www.doe.k12.de.us/domain/36): The State of Delaware has adopted the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) for Math and English/Language Arts (ELA) and is in the process of implementation in schools throughout the state. The CCSS establish clear, consistent guidelines for what every student should know and be able to do in math and ELA from Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Experts and teachers from across the country collaborated to create the standards which are designed to ensure students are prepared for today's entry-level careers, freshman-level college courses, and workforce training programs. The Common Core focuses on helping students develop strategies such as critical-thinking, problem-solving, and analytical skills they will need to be successful. Forty-three states, the District of Columbia, four territories, and the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) have voluntarily adopted and are moving forward with implementation. Delaware is in the process of fully adopting the Next Gen standards for Science.





• World Language Immersion (<u>World Languages & Dual Language Immersion /</u> <u>World Language Welcome (doe.k12.de.us)</u> Delaware's governor created the Governor's World Language Expansion Initiative to help propel Delaware graduates to the forefront of global business and economy in the future. The initiative begins with Chinese and Spanish immersion programs starting in Kindergarten across the state, culminating with students graduating with a proficiency in those languages. World languages are increasingly available in middle schools throughout Delaware even before the first tier of immersion students arrives, giving Delaware students an advantage as they advance in their education and compete in the global workforce economy.
