SUBJECT: Welcome to New Arrivals

Welcome and congratulations on your assignment to Hurlburt Field, home of the Air Commandos. Hurlburt Field privatized family housing in 2013, and the name of our privatized housing partner is Corvias. We are co-located at 123 McMillan Street in building 90371. Our office is easy to find; turn left at the first signal light after entering the main gate, and we are located on the right just past the Youth Center. Contact information is on the left side of our webpage at housing.af.mil/hurlburt.

On-base permanent party unaccompanied housing is only available for E1-E4 personnel. Single SrA over 3 years of service (YOS) or within 60 days of going over 3YOS. and Airmen who are married or have other dependents, may search for off-base housing upon arrival. Unaccompanied personnel in the grades of E1-E4< 3YOS who are married to another military member (MIL-to-Mil), whose spouse will not be joining them within 60 days, must be assigned a dormitory room upon arrival. They may request to move out to establish a household when their spouse and/or other dependents are due to join them within 60 days, or when they reach E4>3YOS, or they are otherwise eligible through the wait list process. All unaccompanied E1-E4 personnel, not excluded above, must report to the Central Dorm Office (Ph: 850-884-3188) in Bldg 90367, room A123, for a room assignment.

If you are eligible, and are interested in residing in privatized housing, please read and return a signed copy of the Housing Referral Briefing located in Featured Documents. You may submit an application directly to Corvias either in person at the housing office, or through their website at airforce.corviasmilitaryliving.com/. If on-base housing is not immediately available, and you apply in advance or within 30 days after arrival, you are placed on a waiting list effective the date you departed last assignment. Otherwise, your application is effective on date of walk-in.

The Military Housing Office (MHO) provides referral assistance to military and DoD personnel and families with their search for housing in the local area, verifies eligibility of military members applying for privatized housing, and assists military members with request for an electricity deposit waiver. Unfortunately, Gulf Power is the only utility company offering a deposit waiver for active duty military personnel.

The MHO has a Welcome Packet for newcomers containing housing search information along with base maps; information on Florida's Landlord/Tenant Law; Military Clause; public and private schools; utilities contact information, and more.

Additional information to help with your relocation is available in the Base & Community Housing Information/Renting Tips handout located in Featured Documents, and also included in the MHO Welcome Packet. Again, welcome to Hurlburt Field. Please let me know if I can be of further assistance.
