SUBJECT: Family Housing Options

- 1. Welcome! In our effort to help you and your family have a smooth move to Offutt AFB, I want to make you aware of housing options available on and off the installation. Our installation's military family housing is privatized. Rising View, the Project Owner (PO), owns family housing and is responsible for maintaining, repairing and managing housing as required. In addition to having the option to purchase or rent housing in the local community, you also have the option to reside in privatized housing (PH) by signing a Tenant Lease Agreement with Rising View. Unlike community housing, rent for the privatized home of your choice cannot exceed the "with dependent" Basic Allowance Housing rate designated for your rank, and utilities are currently included.
- 2. Our privatized housing is a part of the Air Force's larger initiative to eliminate inadequate housing for Airmen. All of the houses built or renovated under the housing privatization program meet and, in most cases, far exceed the Department of Defense's adequacy housing standards. Privatized housing is very comparable to housing in the local community; in fact, current rental rates for each floorplan are determined based on comparisons to the local market economy. If that market rate is less than your Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH), you will pay the market rate instead of your BAH and keep the difference.

Rising View has also replaced and constructed new community amenities, such as a Community Center, playgrounds, tot lots, walking trails, two full-size basketball courts, six sand volleyball courts and one regulation size soccer field which has improved the quality of life for Airmen and their families. This is an exciting time in the housing arena with marvelous opportunities for our families.

- 3. When you arrive at the installation, call or visit the Military Housing Office (MHO). The housing team will provide you the latest information available on the privatized housing initiative as well as community housing referral services. The MHO is a valuable source in providing school, utility and other community information. I encourage you to visit the Offutt MHO website at www.housing.af.mil/Units/Offutt along with www.homes.mil where you may click on the HEAT icon to request advance assistance and start the application process. GENERAL HOUSING INFORMATION

All military personnel, to include unaccompanied personnel, are encouraged to process through the Military Housing Office (MHO) prior to entering into a rental lease agreement. The office will provide you information regarding any restricted housing areas, if applicable.

Eligible military personnel submit advanced applications for Privatized Housing (PH) via email (55CES.CEIH.OffuttHousing@us.af.mil).

You will need the following to complete an application:

- for Assignment to Housing (DD1746)
- a Sex Offender Discloser and Acknowledgment (AF4422)
- a Privatized Housing Questionnaire
- a copy of your Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders
- a recent full month's Leave and Earning Statement (LES).

Digital copies of the DD1746, AF4422, and Housing Questionnaire can be found on Rising View's website, www.risingview.com. Please note you might be required to provide proof of dependents upon request.

PRIVATIZED HOUSING INFORMATION

All housing units were conveyed to America First Communities (now known as Burlington Capital Properties) on 15 September 2005 as part of the Military Housing Privatization Initiative (MHPI). Rising View Communities will operate, maintain, and manage the homes until 2055.

Housing may be privatized, but the MHO will continue to support your housing needs. The information provided below includes an overview of privatized housing and a brief description of the application process. PRIVATIZED HOUSING OVERVIEW

Privatization has brought significant improvements within the housing community, including the renovation of 484 homes, construction of 914 new homes, walking trails, full and half basketball courts, sand volleyball courts, soccer fields, picnic pavilions, and 60+ new playgrounds. Last but not least "The Pointe at Rising View," a 5,600 gross square feet facility with a 150 max person capacity that is available to housing residents for meetings, weddings, birthday parties, etc.

You will be required to sign a one-year lease. At the end of your commitment, you will automatically transition to a month-to-month obligation and will not be required to sign a new lease. Your Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) is based upon your current rank and dependent status; your rent will be equal to your dependent BAH or current market rate of the home, whichever is the lesser of the two. Your rent includes basic utilities (gas, water, electric, septic, and trash).

Temporary Lodging Facilities (TLFs) are available for incoming military personnel. Historically, March through October are the busiest months for families requiring lodging.

Reservations should be made as far in advance as possible. You can make reservations prior to receiving PCS orders. Reservations must be re-confirmed three days prior to your arrival and will be canceled upon 1800 on the date requested unless late arrival approval is granted in advance. Late arrival may be guaranteed with a VISA, MasterCard, or Government Travel card (on file) and will only be charged for the first night's stay.

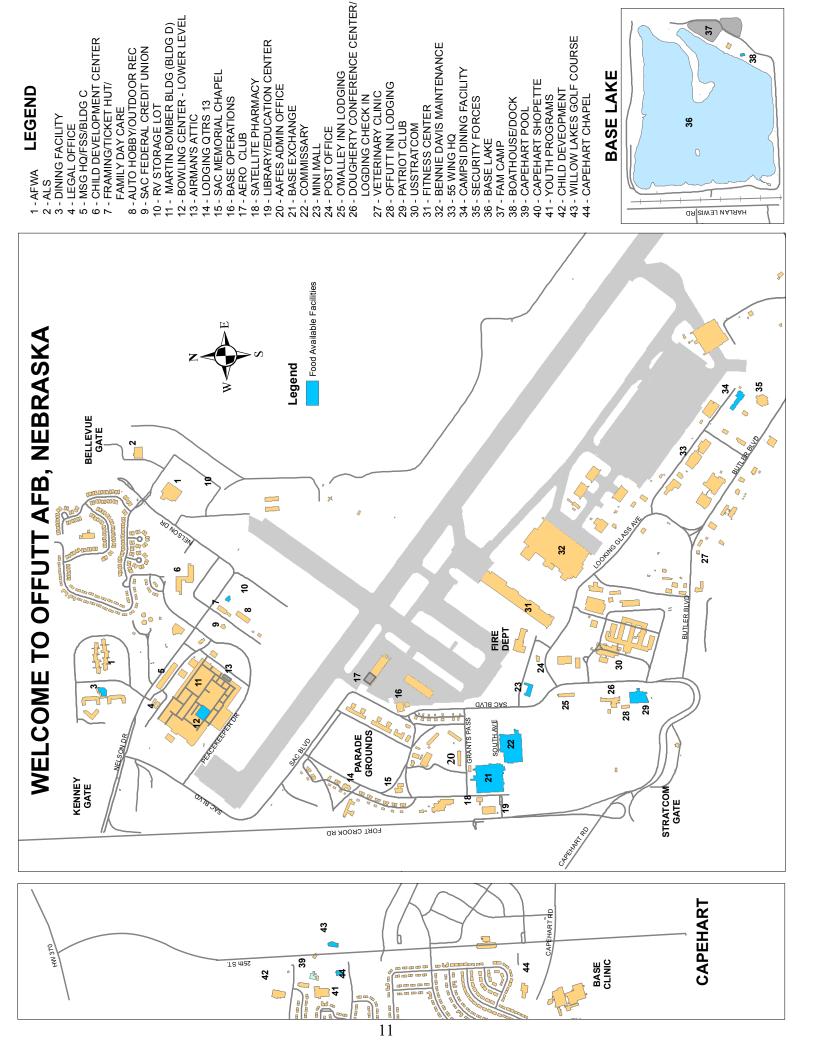

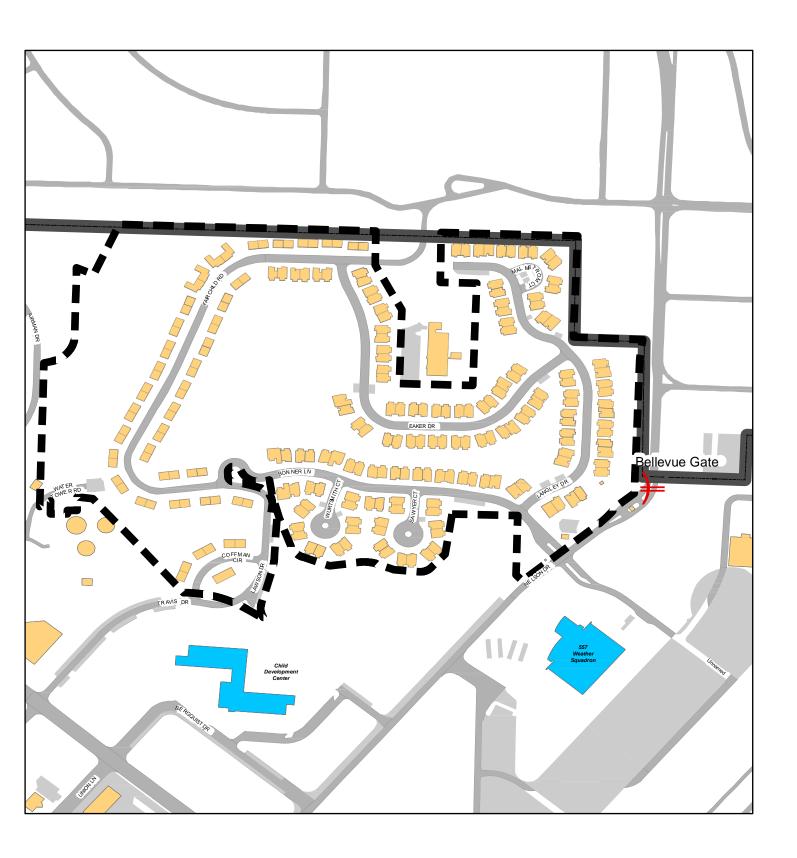
