signment to Edwards Air Force Base. Edwards is the home of the Air Force Test Center and is the Air Force Materiel Command's center for conducting and supporting research and developmental flight test and evaluation of aerospace systems from concept to combat;

plus considerable test activities conducted by America's commercial aerospace industry.



Edwards operates the U.S. Air Force Test Pilot School and is home to NASA's Armstrong Flight Re-

search Center. Edwards is located approximately 100 miles north of Los Angeles, in the Antelope Valley, on the western edge of the Mojave De-



sert. It is near a number of communities including Boron, California City, Lancaster, Mojave, North Edwards, Palmdale, and Rosamond. The installation's approximately 481 square miles (over 308,000 acres) encompasses three counties, the majority in Kern with smaller portions in Los Angeles and San Bernardino.
