▶ Congratulations on being accepted into the Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Program. Unaccompanied officers reside in Building 280 which houses many different officers from multiple countries. This pamphlet will provide the necessary information for your transition into your new home in Texas.

Each pilot is provided their own quiet studio room and private bath which is approximately 350 Sq Ft.

► All UOQ are furnished with one full side captain's bed, love seat, ottoman, two chairs, two night stands, dresser, desk with book case, office chair, and dresser. The kitchen area has a gas range, microwave and refrigerator.

▶ Linens are available but if you prefer, you may use your own linens for the full size bed. The rooms do not include cooking supplies such as pots, pans, dishes, cups, etc...



Pilots have their choice to contact different

companies for internet, cable TV, and phone services. The rooms are all wired but services are <u>not</u> included and is an out-of-pocket expense for each pilot. Satellite dishes are not authorized. Various organizations do offer free WiFi services on SAFB.
